School Uniform Reminders

Now that the heating is fixed and working in school all children should be wearing school uniform. Our colours are red, grey and white.

- Red sweatshirt, jumper or cardigan with or without school logo
- White short-sleeved polo shirt with or without school logo
- School red book bag with school logo
- Grey trousers or grey shorts
- Grey skirt
- Grey pinafore dress
- Red gingham dress
- Black flat shoes

Our uniform does not include long t-shirts under polo shirts or leggings under skirts/dresses or PE shorts. If your child is feeling cold then they should wear a red jumper in school. If they are cold in PE then they should be wearing red or grey jogging bottoms with their white PE t-shirt and red jumper. If you are unsure about items please speak to your class teacher.

All good causes supported by the lottery will benefit Guildford and its residents. Tickets for the lottery cost just £1 per week. Each ticket has a 1 in 50 chance to win a prize each week, with a top prize of £25,000! That's a better chance of winning than the National Lottery or the Health Lottery!</p> <p>Each ticket will consist of 6 numbers and each number will be between 0 and 9. There will be a draw every Saturday night when a 6-digit winning combination will be picked. Prizes will be given to players with tickets that match the first or last 2-6 numbers from the winning combination. Match all 6 and you win the JACKPOT!</p>

<p>As the cold wind this week has reminded us, we are now in winter. Please ensure your child has a suitable coat in school each day.</p> <p>In rare cases due to extreme weather conditions i.e. heavy snowfall; it may be necessary to delay the start of the school day or close the school. In this event parents will be notified via Parent Mail; class reps will be asked to post on class WhatsApp groups and it will be posted on the school website.</p>	<p>So how does it raise funds for our school? When buying your ticket, you can choose which cause you would like to support. From every £1 ticket sold 50p will go to the school plus 10p will be distributed to other good causes in and around Guildford. To put this in perspective when you play the National Lottery only 25% goes to good causes, here it's more than double that.</p> <p>We are currently on track to raise over £800 for the school via ticket sales this year.
